GENESIS & JESUS: LIGHT & DARKNESS

Before God created light, there was D
Literally, Matthew 1:1 reads "the book of the G of Jesus Christ."
On Jan 30, 1956, Martin Luther King told a crowd gathered outside his own bombed-out house that "G"
UNEXPECTED NAMES: HOPE & A FUTURE
Matthew mentions F women in the span of 16 verses (Matt 1:1-16).
T (Matt 1:3) was a Canaanite woman without a husband and faced being Burned (Gen 38:24).
R (Matt 1:5) was a woman from Jericho without a husband, known as a Prostitute (Josh 2:1).
R(Matt 1:5) was a Moabite woman without a husband. Such people were to be kept out of the congregation of Israel (Deut 23:3).
B (Matt 1:6) (the wife of Uriah) was married to a Hittite but was impregnated by David as her husband was murdered.
M (Matt 1:16) was betrothed but not married and was told she would conceive and bear a promised son. Joseph even considered a "divorce."
Psalm 23:4: "I will F no evil, for you are W me." Isaiah 43:1-5: "F not, for I am W you." Matthew 28:20: "I am W you always."
