UNEXPECTED NAMES: HOPE & A FUTURE

Matthew mentions F_____ women in the span of 16 verses (Matt 1:1-16).

T_____ (Matt 1:3) was a Canaanite woman without a husband and faced being Burned (Gen 38:24).

R_____ (Matt 1:5) was a woman from Jericho without a husband, known as a Prostitute (Josh 2:1).

R_____ (Matt 1:5) was a Moabite woman without a husband. Such people were to be kept out of the congregation of Israel (Deut 23:3).

B_____ (Matt 1:6) (the wife of Uriah) was married to a Hittite but was impregnated by David as her husband was murdered.

M_____ (Matt 1:16) was betrothed but not married and was told she would conceive and bear a promised son. Joseph even considered a “divorce.”

Psalm 23:4: “I will F_____ no evil, for you are W_____ me.”

Isaiah 43:1-5: “F_____ not, for I am W_____ you.”

Matthew 28:20: “I am W_____ you always.”
