Identity (#2): A Beautiful Soul

(Genesis 1:26; 2:7) February 19, 2023

SOMETHING MORE

We experience greater and greater need because we are N our soul.
"Why are you cast down, O my S? And why are you in turmoil within me?" (Psalm 43:5 ESV)
PROBLEMS WITH SELF
P means "the study of the soul", but our modern story has led us away from the soul to the S
Augustine: "You have made us for yourself, and our hearts are restless until they Rin you."
Our souls T for God (Psalm 42:1).
LIVING SOUL, IMAGE & LIKENESS OF GOD
Genesis 2:7 says man became a "N K " (living creature), which is also true of all animals (Gen 1:21, 24). It says man has "B of L " in his nostrils, which is also true of all land animals (Gen 6:17; 7:15, 22). It says man is made "of D " which is also true of beasts of the field (Ecc 3:19-21). But it also says God F man and B the breath of life (see Isa 54:16; Ezek 37; John 20:22), which speak to human uniqueness as living "souls."
Soul means "the whole human being seen from the point of view of one's I life." (N. T. Wright)
Genesis 1:26 says humans are made in the I and L of God. We all have this, but we also find the full result of this in Christ and the renewal of the Holy Spirit.
THE SOUL'S LONGING
The soul cannot endure some things. We long for something better. And we find what our soul longs for in C
Answers: Neglecting; Soul; Psychology; Self; Rest; Thirst; Nephesh Kaya; Breath; Life; Dust; Formed; Breathed; Inner; Image; Likeness; Christ
