### **Accepted**

*(John 3:16-18; Romans 8:1)*

*March 12, 2023*

### **NOT GUILTY**

Jesus tells the woman caught in the act of adultery: “I do not C\_\_\_\_\_ you either. Go, but do not sin again” (John 8:11 GNT).

### **LOVE FOR THE WORLD**

John 3:16 shows God’s U\_\_\_\_\_ love for the world, since he loved us when we were ungodly and enemies of the cross (See also Rom 5:6-11).

### **NO CONDEMNATION**

John 3:17 says that God did not send His Son into the world to C\_\_\_\_\_ it.

There is now no C\_\_\_\_\_ for those who are in Christ Jesus (Rom 8:1; see also Rom 8:31-39).

John 3:18 says that whoever believes in Him is not C\_\_\_\_\_.

### **FORGIVEN FOREVER**

1 John 1:7 says the blood of Jesus (continually) cleanses us from A\_\_\_\_\_ our sins.

1 John 1:9 says God is faithful and just to F\_\_\_\_\_ us our sins.

1 John 2:1 says Jesus Christ, the righteous one, is our A\_\_\_\_\_ to plead our case on the basis of His own death for our sins.

1 John 3:20 says that when our heart condemns us, God is G\_\_\_\_\_ than our heart.

1 John 5:13 says that John wrote his letter to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may K\_\_\_\_\_ that you have eternal life.
