## FINDING MY IDENTITY: FOLLOW YOUR HEART?

Contemporary western culture says that finding your identity involves following the desires of your H
But Christians believe "the heart is D above all things, and desperately wicked/sick" (Jeremiah 17:9 ESV).
<b>THOUGHT</b> (Prov 14:12; 16:25; 18:17; Mt 9:4; 13:15; 15:19; Mk 6:52; 7:21; 8:17; Jn 12:40; Acts 16:14; Rom 1:21; 6:18; 12:1-2; Gal 6:3; Eph 1:18; 4:18; Heb 10:22; James 1:26)
Heart can refer to the seat of I: how we think or what we understand (Matt 13:15; John 12:40)
My identity is NOT what I think apart from the W of God.
<b>DESIRES</b> (Jn 16:6; Acts 2:37; 7:39; Rom 1:24; 9:2; 2 Cor 2:4; Eph 6:22; Col 2:2; 4:8; 2 Thess 1:16-17; James 3:14; 5:8; 1 John 3:19-21)
Heart can refer to the seat of E: how we feel or what we desire (Acts 2:37; 2 Cor 2:4)
My identity is NOT what I feel or desire apart from the R of God.
<b>DUTIES</b> (Mt 6:16-17; Lk 17:10; 18:9-14; Acts 5:4; 13:2, 3; 14:23; 2 Cor 9:7; Phil 3:4-11; 1 Jn 4:10)
Heart can refer to the seat of the W: how we act, what we purpose, or decide to do (2 Cor 9:7; Acts 5:4)
My identity is NOT what I do or even obey over and above the P of God.
Answers: Heart; Deceitful; Intelligence; Wisdom; Emotions; Reordering; Will; Person.
