Acts 2:47 • July 9, 2023

A GOSPEL OF OFFENSE

| Paul speaks of the "offense of the C" (Gal 5:11), and that God lays in Zion a stone of S, a rock of offense (Isa 8:14; Rom 9:33; 1 Pet 2:8) |
|--|
| We should expect to suffer as a C (1 Pet 4:12-16), realizing that Jesus his followers would be persecuted and even, on occasion, be H by all (Matt 10:22). |
| NO ADDITIONAL OFFENSE |
| Giving no additional offense is for P reasons (Prov 18:19), follows the E of our Lord (Matt 17:27), obeys the C of God (1 Cor 10:31-33), and is in keeping with the E of the Apostle Paul (Acts 25:8). |
| BE HIGHLY FAVORED |
| Luke tells us we are to be in favor with G (Lk 1:30; 2:52; Acts 7:46) and with P (Lk 2:52; Acts 2:47; 7:10). |
| Jesus taught that the "year of the Lord's Favor" often involves God giving and serving O (Lk 4:18ff). |
| Paul teaches us to be concerned how we are perceived by outsiders in our A (1 Cor 14:16-24), in our daily W (Col 4:5; 1 Thess 4:12), and in who we choose to be a S (1 Tim 3:7). |
| LIVING WITNESS |
| You may be the only Bible some people ever R |
