Acts 2:47 • July 16, 2023

RAPID GROWTH

The early church grew from a few thousand members to in 3 centuries. In that time, they went from 1/1000 th of the world's population to% of the world population. That is a growth rate of% per decade. (Rodney Stark, <i>The Rise of Christianity</i>)
A LIFE, NOT A METHOD
The model of growth for the New Testament church concerns a L, not a method. It involves embracing a G that changes everything, and a vision of that gospel that people couldn't help but fall in L with. Then it describes a people who took that love, that gospel, with unbelievable and utter S (Matt 5:16; Acts 2:41-47; 4:13; 5:12-13)
HOW TO STIFLE GROWTH
Paul said "you are witnesses of how we L among you believers. God is also a witness" (1 Thess 2:10)
By Violence & Worldliness. In 1994, R was considered the most Christian nation in Africa. Tribal warfare led to 800,000 deaths in just 100 days.
By In-Fighting & Division. Churches of Christ in the United States have less adherents than we had in 19 List the splintering sub-groups you interact with personally:
RELATIONSHIPS LEADING TO FRIENDSHIP
The early Christians not only shared the gospel; they shared their L(1 Thess 1:5; 2:8).
