Matthew 7:6-23 • November 5, 2023

A TIME FOR CHOOSING

Matthew 7 is less about what we do or think, and more about who we A(character) and <i>whose</i> we are (belonging).
DON'T TRUST A PHARISEE
#1: God W the people they shun (Mk 2:16)
#2: God's N work can't fit into their old framework (Mk 2:18)
#3: They think that people were made for R (Mk 2:24)
#4: Their teaching leads to choosing E over good, and death over life (N 3:4)
TWO KINDS OF FRUIT
Jesus begins with the moral category of G (Mt 7:10, 17-19).
It is possible to be a heretic in the T, if our behavior and character do no produce what is good (Titus 3:10-11; 3 Jn 9-11; 2 Tim 2:16-18; Heb 12:15; Lk 18:9).
TWO KINDS OF TEACHERS
Wolves in sheep's clothing are not trying to imitate the sheep; they are trying to imitate the S (Jer 6:14; 8:11; Zech 13:4).
TWO KINDS OF RELIGION
One kind of religion breathes new L into you; the other kind zaps the L out of you.
The Pharisees looked D on sinners (Lk 18:18); Jesus looked F them (Lk 19:10).
