Group Icebreaker: Watch a video together of just how big the universe is! NASA's Webb Space telescope has some beautiful pictures as well.

Question 1: In the beginning was the "Word" that God used to create all things (John 1:1-3; Genesis 1:3; Hebrews 1:2-3). How big and powerful must the "Word" be? Discuss how **BIG** God is, and how powerful his **WORD** is.

Question 2: This same powerful word that created everything came to us as a baby in a manger (Matthew 2:1-11; Luke 2:1-20; John 1:9-14; Hebrews 1:1-4). How is this possible? How amazing is it that God came to us to be like us, one of us, and with us? Discuss how **LOVING** God is, and how he wanted to be with us.

Question 3: Since the same God who made all living things also became a living person, that means everyone and everything has value. How should we see the work of God when we look up into the sky? How should we see the work of God when we look at other people? Discuss how **PRESENT** God is, in all things.

Final Activity: Go out into your yard and stare at the night sky. Imagine Jesus coming all the way to earth, just for you. Now say to each other "I see Jesus in you." Pray, thanking God for sending Jesus.
