Mark 4:30-34 • March 3, 2024

In the gospels, people constantly misunderstand Jesus (John 3:3-4; Matt 16:5-11; Luke 22:35-38; Matt 27:46-47), partly because he spoke in parables. This shows that G matters.

Common Mistakes
Reading The OT As Principles & The New Testament As Directives Verse Chains: Mixing Genres To Push A Narrative P T: Making 1:1 Application of Practices Without Further Insight
Takeaways
Ask For the Genre, Soak Up The Story Look First For G Look Second For P Look Third For Consistent P Rooted In Principles
