2 Timothy 2:1-2 • March 17, 2024

- 1) S\_\_\_\_\_ Matters (& Is Primary)
- 2) R\_\_\_\_\_ Matters (Acts 17:2, 17; 18:4-19; 19:8-9; 24:45; 26:35)
- 3) E\_\_\_\_\_ Matters (Deut. 1:13, 15; 11:2; Josh 24:31; 2 Cor. 16:15)
- 4) T\_\_\_\_\_ Matters (1 Cor. 11:2; 2 Thess. 2:15; 3:6; 2 Tim. 2:1-2)
- 5) Read W\_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. When I see something in S\_\_\_\_\_ that accords with R\_\_\_\_\_, fits my E\_\_\_\_\_, and has long been S\_\_\_\_\_ in Christian tradition, I find a reading, belief, or practice to follow.
  - b. When I see something in S\_\_\_\_\_ that does **not** accord with R\_\_\_\_\_, does **not** fit my E\_\_\_\_\_, and has **never** been S\_\_\_\_\_ in Christian tradition, I find a reading, belief, or practice that is unlikely.
- 6) Read C\_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. When there is a belief or practice that fits with S\_\_\_\_\_ but not A\_\_\_\_\_, I default to the C\_\_\_\_\_ wisdom and C\_\_\_\_\_ practice of the church.
