## **In This Together**

Ephesians 4:1-6 • May 5, 2024

## **Three Questions**

1. Is Salvation By Grace Through Faith?
Salvation is by G (Rom 11:5-6; Eph 2:1-9; Titus 3:3-7) through F (Rom 4:4-5, 16; Eph 2:8; Rom 10:9).
But this includes a whole-self response of faith, including B (compare Rom 10:9-13 with baptism texts).
2. Which baptisms count? Do I need to be rebaptized?
Our conversion is not to baptism but to C
Conversion is a story of G at work.
The only example of rebaptism in the NT involved knowledge of the S (Acts 19).
Paul is against anyone serving as the "S D" to approve people.
3. If baptism unites us, why are we divided?
Paul (in Ephesians 4) and Peter (in 1 Peter 3) argue that baptism means we are "in this T"
Answers: Grace; Faith; Baptism; Christ; God; Spirit; Screen Door; Together.
