THE BEAUTY OF MOTHER'S DAY.

Reflect on the joy of a day to celebrate mother's and motherhood. Why is this a good thing? (Hint: it IS!)

THE TRUE STORY OF FAMILY **TREES.** Every family tree has a few nuts and squirrels. But for some, their direct relationships (parents, grandparents, etc) left much to be desired, making Mother's Day difficult. Can you relate to the difficulty of finding "blessing" when ones past was less than optimal? Discuss.

JESUS' FAMILY TREE. Read Matthew 1:1-16. Pay attention to each name in this list. How many of these names are associated with scandal at one time or another? Abraham lied (Gen 12:10-20). Jacob swindled (Gen 27-29). Judah was a hypocrite (Gen 28). How David and Bathsheba met is a story you didn't tell in polite company (2 Sam 11:2-3). Rahab was a harlot (Josh 2:1). Manasseh was a monster (2 Kings 21:6). What does this teach us?

GOD BRINGS BLESSING **AND PROMISE** TO THE **FLAWED** THROUGH THE FLAWED. Read Galatians 3:14. The promise to Abraham (a flawed character) is now a promise to us (flawed characters). All because of the perfect Son of God. Discuss.

CALL BLESSED ALL THROUGH WHOM GOD'S **GRACE** HAS EXTENDED. Read Luke 1:48. Mary does not consider herself blessed because of her character, but rather her vocation. How is this true about all who went before her as well? Discuss.

BLESSING IS ULTIMATELY ABOUT LORDSHIP, NOT LINEAGE. Read Luke 11:27-28. How does Jesus change how we view our place and role? Where is true blessing found?

THE CALL TO BLESSING IS FOR EVERYONE. Read Matt 25:34, 1 John 2:2 & Rev 22:17. God wants every nut and squirrel to belong. How does this change our view of others?
