3 Titles:

- (1) “Jesus C _____” reveals that Jesus is human and connects him with Israel’s history (John 1:14; Gal 4:4; Matt 13:55; Heb 2:14-17)
- (2) “God’s only (begotten) S _____” reveals that Jesus is divine and connects him with the Father (Matt 3:17; Mk 1:11; Matt 17:5; Lk 9:35; Heb 1:3; Matt 1:23; John 5:18; Col 2:9)
- (3) “Our L _____” grants language to Jesus that belongs only to God, revealing that in having to do with Jesus, we are having to do with God (1 Kings 18:39; Hosea 6:1-3; Phil 2:5-11; Isaiah 45:18-23; Rom 10:9; John 20:28; Titus 2:13; 2 Pet 1:1; Matt 28:18)
